CHAMPAGNE

- £85.00 MOSAÏQUE SIGNATURE, CHAMPAGNE JACQUART
NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Intense, floral and fruity aromas with a musky tinge and lingering apple and pear notes.
- £90.00 BRUT MOSAÏQUE ROSÉ, CHAMPAGNE JACQUART
NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
This medium bodied rosé is reminiscent of the power and finesse of the non-vintage label, with a soft red-fruit core.
- £110.00 TAITTINGER, BRUT RÉSERVE
NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Crisp, citrus aromas with a lively, mousse texture and a crisp, flavourful finish.
- £140.00 BLANC DE BLANCS, CHAMPAGNE JACQUART
2013 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Superlative Chardonnay-only Champagne, scented with cherry blossom, vanilla and still warm brioche, proffering a mouthful of white peaches and citrus.
- £165.00 BLANC DE BLANCS, PORTE NOIRE
2010 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Notes of crystallised citrus fruits, fresh-out-the-oven frangipane tart, plus a slight salinity typical of expression of Chardonnay from chalky soil. Mature, compelling and delicious.
- £180.00 RUINART BLANC DE BLANCS
NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
A persistent release of bubbles with floral aromas followed by white peaches and pineapple notes. The palate is supple and rounded with nectarines, citrus fruits and a very refreshing finish.

2010 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
This vintage Champagne smells like a flower garden crossed with an orchard, with acacia, honeysuckle and poppies supplemented by cherry and red apple, all enhanced by a waft of toasted bread and honey.
- £380.00 CUVÉE DOM PERIGNON, MOËT AND CHANDON
2010 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Delicious Dom, a delicate bouquet of pastel flowers, a handful of candied fruits and a scattering of toast, hay and liquorice.

- £820.00 DOM PÉRIGNON PLENITUDE P2
2002 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Dom Pérignon Champagnes evolve through a series of plenitudes – points at which they reach full expression. The 1998 vintage has reached its second plénitude, revealing a broader flavour profile. P2 Blanc 1998 has been matured for 16 years, meaning the characteristic dark, mineral, spiced singularity of Dom Pérignon is clearer than ever. This is a remarkably complex and intense vintage.

NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Undoubtedly the King of Champagne; rich and complex with a toasty, nutty character, fresh lemony acidity and the finest, most delicate bubbles imaginable.

2009 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Elegant, deep, and silky-textured, this medium to full-bodied beauty is immensely concentrated, pure, packed with apple flavours, and astoundingly long in the finish.

SPARKLING WINE

- £59.00 DELLA VITE SUPERIOR, DOC, ITALY
Extra dry with aromas of citrus blossom and a rich mineral palate characterised by hints of crostini and chamomile.
- £62.00 DELLA VITE ROSÉ, MILLESIMATO, DOC, ITALY
Elegant, pale coral pink in colour with an aromatic nose of freshly crushed wild berries and rhubarb. Balanced by a creamy texture and fine bubbles leading to a long, smooth finish.





EIGHT CLUB VINEYARD
MAS DES TANNES, LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

Situated in the Languedoc, central Southern France, the Mas des Tannes vineyard lies in a privileged position, protected by pine trees and the garrigue; nourished by the mild climate of the Mediterranean Sea and the healthy northern wind. It is rich in organic life deep in its clayed-limestone soils, which have never come into contact with synthetic chemicals. The vines are naturally resistant and vigorous, the fruits are concentrated and full of life, and the wines are balanced and characterful.

From this excellent location, we are pleased to bring you three organic wines created by renowned Languedoc wine producers Paul Mas.

- £40.00 MAS DES TANNES RESERVE BLANC ORGANIC
Grenache Blanc (100%)
The nose reveals notes of stone fruits (peaches, apricots) and tropical fruits with a hint of vanilla. The medium-bodied wine is creamy and smooth on the palate. Well-balanced and refreshing acidity.
- £42.50 MAS DES TANNES CLASSIQUE ROUGE ORGANIC
Grenache (45%) Mourvedre (35%) Carignan (20%)
Part of the wine is aged in oak barrels for five months. A deep ruby colour. Expressive nose with notes of blueberries, blackberries, cooked fruits and vanilla. Rich and full-bodied on the palate, this generous wine offers jammy notes with a long and spicy finish.
- £46.50 MAS DES TANNES RESERVE ROUGE ORGANIC
Cabernet Sauvignon (55%) Grenache (35%) Mourvedre (10%)
Aged in oak for six months. Deep ruby with garnet tints. The nose is expressive with notes of cherries, blueberries, plums, spices (liquorice) and oak. Full-bodied on the palate, this concentrated wine reveals aromas of ripe dark fruits and spices supported by smooth and soft tannins. Long and spicy finish with hints of vanilla and toast.





ORIN SWIFT SELECTION

Founded in 1998 by innovator and winemaker Dave Phinney, Orin Swift's creative and exciting approach to brand innovation has led it to become a global luxury wine brand.

The story behind the name Orin Swift, well that's a little simpler, the name is derived from Phinney's mother's maiden name and Phinney's father's middle name.

MANNEQUIN CALIFORNIA CHARDONNAY

The wine has a big palate, full of rich aromatics of Meyer lemon, honeydew, butterscotch and honeysuckle, with accents of jasmine, white pepper and fennel pollen. A layered mid-palate of nectarines, pineapple and honey is kept fresh by good acidity and leads to an elegant, long finish.

ABSTRACT CALIFORNIA RED WINE (GRENACHE/SYRAH/PETIT SYRAH)

Pronounced aromas of blueberry, plum, raspberry, cherry and enchanting musk leap from the glass leading to a palate of black plum, sweet cassis and blueberry compote with a textured, long finish with a hint of dried lavender and dark chocolate.

The bottle is an assembly of numerous individual images that together create a grander piece of art, a statement. Close up, each image speaks for itself, but from afar, they meld away and become one with the others. Abstract has followed its namesake by showing off an assemblage of Grenache, Syrah & Petit Syrah, each varietal bringing its own unique characteristics providing depth and complexity not possible on their own. When blended, they become much more than they could ever be.

PALERMO NAPA VALLEY (CABERNET SAUVIGNON /MERLOT/CAB FRANC)

A brooding red core with a rich cardinal hued rim, the wine opens with classic Napa Cabernet Sauvignon aromatics: ripe cassis, sunburst raspberry, graphite and chapparal surrounded by a balanced frame of new oak. The bold aromatics translate onto the palate seamlessly with more cassis, red liquorice, fresh fennel and mixed berry compote. Integrated yet prominent puckering tannins finish off the wine with a touch of lingering black tea.





- £135.50 MACHETE
(PETITE SYRAH/SYRAH/GRENACHE)
Each bottle of Machete is a little different from the next thanks to Orin Swift's bold collaboration with avantgarde photographer Caitlin Mitchell. In total there are twelve labels, each bearing a breath-taking image which captures a distinct aspect of this quirky wine's personality.
Powerful aromas of creme de cassis, boysenberry, and ripe cherries with a soft minerality and hints of dark chocolate can be found on the nose. On the palate, dark plums are prominent with hints of vanilla and chocolate, enhanced by a smooth velvety texture.
- £135.50 SLANDER CALIFORNIA PINOT NOIR
Emerging from the bottle with a glowing cardinal hue, the 2019 Slander opens with a mouth-watering nose of bright strawberry and Rainier cherry with shades of milk chocolate, passion fruit and pink guava.
- £155.50 PAPILLON NAPA VALLEY RED WINE
(BORDEAUX BLEND)
A neon indigo pours into the glass and sits with a dark garnet core and a lucid cardinal tint. A boisterous nose escapes the glass with aromatics of ripe boysenberry, kirsch, mixed dark berry pie, California Coastal sagebrush and chaparral. Delectable and plush on the palate, notes of blackberry and sweet black liquorice culminate in a finish of dusty tannins and ripe black plum.
- £125.50 8 YEARS IN THE DESERT
(ZINFANDEL)
Orin Swift, 8 Years In The Desert 2019 Zinfandel is a dry, full-bodied and juicy Zin with plum compote, crushed raspberry, anise and cinnamon spice lush and concentrated on the palate. Lots of good acidity for food and tannins are fresh and chewy. Enjoy with burgers and ribs from the grill.
- £246.00 MERCURY HEAD NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON
The entry is elegant and begins to flood the palate with notes of cassis, blackberry, blueberry, caramel and a touch of brown sugar and cinnamon: rich and bold. Seamless and focused, the wine closes with lingering dusty tannins and a touch of baking chocolate.

WHITE WINE ‡ BY THE GLASS

- £10.50 BACKSBERG CHENIN BLANC, SOUTH AFRICA
Aromatic characters include peach, melon, and pineapple. Balanced acidity to give a mouth-filling yet refreshing palate.
- £11.00 TARON BLANCO RIOJA, SPAIN
A crisp and fresh white made from the local Viura variety. The bouquet has notes of citrus, green apple and white blossom.
- £11.50 ODISSEIA HARVEST WHITE, DOURO VALLEY, PORTUGAL
Citrus color, with citrus and white fruit aromas. Medium concentration in the mouth, very fresh and balanced.
- £12.00 SAUVIGNON BLANC, WAIRAU RIVER FAMILY VINEYARDS
Marlborough's warm days and cool nights create an extended growing season allowing the grapes to develop beautiful acidity which balances the intense varietal characteristics of ripe grapefruit, white nectarine, and tropical fruits resulting in elegant, refreshing, crisp flavours.
- £13.50 GAVI DI GAVI, CONTI SPERONE, ITALY
A springtime blossom and green apples on the nose. These attractive aromas follow through to the palate combining with notes of white peach and a zippy grapefruit finish.
- £15.00 ST. VERAN, MOULIN DU PONT, DOMAINE AUVIGUE, FRANCE
Wonderfully structured, showing white fruits with hazelnut and a hint of citrus to provide balance. This full-bodied southern Burgundy had extended lees ageing.

The palate is rich with black cherry and plum flavours with a hint of mineral character.
- £12.00 HAMILTON HEIGHTS, SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA
A smooth palate with juicy black fruit flavours and a hint of spicy pepper.
- £12.50 ODISSEIA HARVEST RED, DOURO VALLEY, PORTUGAL
An intriguing expression of black fruits, followed by aromas of tobacco, mushrooms and liquorice in the background. Refined and lively attack, with notes of black berries, undergrowth, mellow tannins, and a long spicy finish.
- £13.00 FAMILIA SHROEDER, MALBEC, PATAGONIA ALPACATO
This is a fresh and fruity wine that carries blackcurrant, black cherry, plum and violet
- £15.00 CHATEAU GACHON, MONTAGNE ST. EMILION, FRANCE
A well balanced with a solid tannic structure and a complementary soft mid-palate of ripe fruits such as plums and red berries.
- £16.50 PAPALE ORO PRIMITIVO DI MANDURIA, VARVAGLIONE, PUGLIA, ITALY
Smooth with balanced flavours of wood, fruit, vanilla, ripened cherry and plum.

ROSÉ WINE † BY THE GLASS

- £11.00 CHATEAU D'ECLANS. THE PALE ROSÉ, PROVENCE, FRANCE
Aromas of apple, peach, cantaloupe melon, lemon and pomelo.
A medium bodied rose with a tangy acidity and a fruity, easy palate.
- £12.00 CÔTEAUX D'AIX EN PROVENCE, TERRE DES ANGES PARADIS, FRANCE
Bright, appealing Provençal rosé from the French Riviera, balanced by a fresh acidity and ripe fruit flavours of strawberries, red cherries and peach.





WHITE WINE ‡ LIGHT, CRISP & FRUITY

- £37.50 TARON BLANCO RIOJA, SPAIN
A crisp and fresh white made from the local Viura variety. The bouquet has notes of citrus, green apple and white blossom.
- £38.00 VINHO VERDE AZAL, PORTUGAL
A light, crisp and zesty white from northwest Portugal. This Azal has delicate floral and citrus notes on the nose. The palate is very fresh with a zingy acidity and notes of green apple, white peach, grapefruit and a hint of elderflower.
- £39.00 PICPOUL IGP, RICHEMER, LANGUEDOC ROUSSILLON, FRANCE
Lively and fresh with lemon touch on the palate; final on a mineral and salty note.
- £42.50 SAUVIGNON BLANC, WAIRAU RIVER FAMILY VINEYARDS
This is an elegant wine with intense tropical and stone fruit aromatics with delicate citrus and floral notes.
- £49.50 VESEVO BENEVENTANO FALANGHINA CAMPANIA, ITALY
A slight pine scent, but is better known for its citrus-blossom aromas, in particular bitter orange.
- £52.00 PAULLET WINES, RIESLING 'POLISH HILL RIVER' SINGLE VINEYARD
Very aromatic, highlighted by intense fresh lemon/lime, white flowers and green apple supported by hints of slate.
- £53.00 GAVI DI GAVI, CONTI SPERONE, ITALY
A springtime blossom and green apples on the nose. These attractive aromas follow through to the palate combining with notes of white peach and a zippy grapefruit finish.
- £60.00 CHABLIS, DOMAINE GAUTHERON, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Elegant mineral quality that is typical of wines from the Chablis region.
- £65.00 POUILLY FUMÉ LES PIERRES BLANCHES, DOMAIN BELAIR, LOIRE, FRANCE
Aromas are subtle and include mild lemon, white flowers, citrus blossoms, and hints of acacia and honeysuckle.

Aromatic characters include peach, melon and pineapple. Balanced acidity to give a mouth-filling, yet refreshing, palate.
- £39.50 VERDICCHIO DI MATELICA, TERRE DI VALBONA, ITALY
A pale lemon wine with a lovely aromatic and clean bouquet showing perfumes of acacia and a touch of honey.
- £40.00 MANDRAROSSA, CIACA BIANCA FIANO, ITALY
This wine is a bright straw yellow colour. On the nose, it has herbaceous notes and hints of exotic fruits.
- £52.00 ODISSEIA HARVEST WHITE, DOURO VALLEY, PORTUGAL
Citrus color, with citrus and white fruit aromas. Medium concentration in the mouth, very fresh and balanced.
- £49.50 PINOT GRIGIO, GRAVEDEL FRUIT, LE MONDE, ITALY
A supple structure, sustained by a distinct tangy freshness with delicate, lingering hints of white fruits.
- £52.50 ALTITUDES WHITE, IXSIR, BATROUN, LEBANON
Fragrant and fruity with flavors of freshly cut green apple, juicy pineapple and hints of citrus.
- £66.50 SANCERRE, DOMAINE ANDRE NEVEU, LOIRE, FRANCE
Well balanced and round in the mouth, the immense long notes of gooseberries and citrus combine with the crisp flinty notes which linger on the finish.
- £125.00 ICON SANTORINI ASSYRTIKO, ANHYDROUS, GREECE
Dense fruit: nectarines, apricots and lemon blossom presence of sea breeze with remarkable salinity. On the palate the wine has sharp acidity and minerality. Clean, strict, with a strong structure.

On the palate a balance of creaminess and acidity. The finish delivers notes of tree-ripened citrus, apple & even tropical banana.
- £66.50 ST. VERAN, MOULIN DU PONT, DOMAINE AUVIGUE, FRANCE
Wonderfully structured, showing white fruits with hazelnut and a hint of citrus to provide balance. This full bodied southern Burgundy had extended lees ageing.
- £120.00 CHÂTEAU DE CHAMIREY MERCUREY BLANC, FAMILLE DEVILLARD, FRANCE
Intense notes of lychee and pineapple, with subtle spices of anise, clove, and white pepper.
- £175.00 PULIGNY MONTRACHET, DOMAINE JEAN PASCAL, FRANCE
Complex, full bodied with a lovely use of oak and a nose of butter, minerals and toasty vanilla.

Aromas of apple, peach, cantaloupe melon, lemon and pomelo.
A medium bodied rose with a tangy acidity and a fruity, easy
palate.
- £59.50 COTEAUX D'AIX EN PROVENCE, TERRE DES ANGES,
PARADIS, FRANCE
Terre des Anges is a luxurious and elegant rose, partical wood fermentation on
the Mourvedre gives texture and richness which is balanced by a fresh acidity and
ripe fruit flavours of strawberries, red cherries and peach.
- £76.50 WHISPERING ANGEL, CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE
It has fresh notes of apple, pink grapefruit, peach and cream, and a long,
smooth finish. At its very best with smoked salmon.
- £89.00 ROCK ANGEL, FRANCE
A very pure and incisive nose, with refined mineral chalkiness to the fresh
strawberry and grapefruit aromas.





RED WINE ‡ LIGHT, FRUITY & VIBRANT

- £37.50 LOS CAMINOS, MERLOT, COLCHAGUA, CHILE
The palate is rich with black cherry and plum flavours with a hint of mineral character.
- £40.50 CHATEAU LE BRETON, BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR
Deep ruby in colour with dark plum notes on the nose. The palate has ripe black fruit characters combined with a mineral note from the soils and a touch of clove and cinnamon spice from 6 months oak ageing.
- £53.00 ODISSEIA HARVEST RED, DOURO VALLEY, PORTUGAL
An intriguing expression of black fruits, followed by aromas of tobacco, mushrooms and liquorice in the background. Refined and lively attack, with notes of black berries, undergrowth, mellow tannins, and a long spicy finish.
- £54.00 FLEURIE, DOMAINE PATRICK TRANCHAND, CÔTE DE PONCIE, FRANCE
Full of red fruits and forest fruits, elegantly arranged in the mouth.
- £49.00 MANDRAROSSA, COSTADUNE, NERO D'AVOLA, ITALY
Black cherry, prune, black plum, and liquorice. It often exudes a herbal and cherry aroma that matches its fruity nature.
- £80.00 CA MOMI, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY, USA
A wonderfully rich and complex Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa Valley. The nose is complex and layered, with notes of black cherry, cassis, bitter chocolate and spice.
- £120.00 MERCUREY DOMAINE DE BELLEVILLE, MERCUREY ROUGE 'CHAMP LADOY', FRANCE
A fleshy cherry and blackcurrant flavours beautifully balanced with velvety smooth tannins and a hint of minerality.

Soft and smooth with notes of sweet black cherries and blackcurrant fruits combined with notes of cinnamon and cloves.
- £51.00 CHONO, SINGLE VINEYARD SERIES, PINOT NOIR, CASABLANCA VALLEY COSTA, CHILE
An intense and fresh nose of red fruits, enriched with spicy notes.
- £66.00 HAUTES-CÔTES DE BEAUNE, DOMAINE DU PRIEURÉ, FRANCE
A purity of fruit and captivating perfume of summer berries with a soft, silky finish.
- £69.00 FLOR DE VETUS TORO SPAIN
Well balanced and structured with a medium to full body and a pleasant, succulent finish.
- £79.00 CASTELLO VICCHIOMAGGIO, CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA 'AGOSTINO PETRI' 2017 ITALY
A perfumed and elegant wine, showing aromas of dark cherry and violet complemented by a touch of cedar.

Full bodied with a velvety texture and notes of black fruits, bitter chocolate, walnuts and cinnamon.

- £40.50 HAMILTON HEIGHTS, SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA
A smooth palate with juicy black fruit flavours and a hint of spicy pepper.
- £42.50 CÔTES DU RHÔNE ROUGE, 'MISRAL', FRANCE
It offers violets and herbal notes on the nose, with attractive strawberry and mulberry fruit.
- £98.50 DIAPOROS SINGLE VINEYARD XINOMAVRO, KTIMA
KIR-YIANNI
The Xinomavro grape is sometimes called the Greek Pinot Noir and this is complex and delicious with fine acidity and flavours of strawberry, violet, chocolate and vanilla.
- £130.00 DONATELLA COLOMBINI, BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO,
ITALY
The nose opens to delicate flowers and violets with wild cherry and a hint of eucalyptus. It's elegant and clean, offering ripe Marasca cherry, liquorice and dried mint framed in well balanced tannins.





RED WINE ‡ FULL BODIED & CLASSIC

- £47.50 ALPATACO MALBEC, PATAGONIA, ARGENTINA
A fresh and fruity wine that carries blackcurrant, black cherry, plum and violet. Delicious notes of vanilla and chocolate notes from ageing in small oak barrels.
- £49.00 FIOR DI SOLE, LONG BARN, ZINFADEL, USA
With notes of sweet black cherries, brambles and chewy tannins.
- £58.50 CHÂTEAU GACHON, MONTAGNE ST. EMILION, FRANCE
Well balanced with a solid tannic structure and a complementary soft mid-palate of ripe fruits such as plums and red berries.
- £61.00 FINCA SOPHENIA, ESTATE RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON, ARGENTINA
Earthy blackberry aromas are more spicy and complex than outright ripe and jammy, while this feels tightly composed and drawing on the palate.
- £75.00 PAPALE ORO PRIMITIVO DI MANDURIA, VARVAGLIONE.
Smooth with balanced flavours of wood, fruit, vanilla, ripened cherry and plum.
- £95.00 RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN
Full bodied, creamy palate with smooth tannins, juicy ripe fruits and a hint of cedar.
- £145.00 CHÂTEAU D'ANGLUDET, MARGAUX 2016, FRANCE
Lovely, sweet, cool fruit on the nose with a hint of spice. It has a suave, ribbon-like texture with red fruit and violets coming through.
- £205.00 RIVETTO, BAROLO 'SERRALUNGA' ORGANIC, ITALY
This intense, full bodied red has a wonderful scent of violets and roses. It is harmoniously balanced, rich with tar and plum flavours.





DESSERT WINE

- £45.00 SAUTERNES CHÂTEAU LE JUGE “LES MINGETS” FRANCE
A rich and concentrated dessert wine from hand harvested Semillon grapes affected by noble rot and matured in oak barrique.
- £120.00 VIDAL ICEWINE, INNISKILLIN, CANADA
A sweet mouth-feel balanced by bracing acidity and fruit flavours of peach, apricot and a drizzle of honey.
